RECYCLE YOUR CORE - The purpose of a core deposit is to keep boat parts out of the landfill and give you money back on your old unit. Initially, the core deposit amount is included on all order totals. Once you return all the appropriate core parts, we evaluate those parts then refund the core deposit to you within 30 days of receipt of your old core. Please review the full procedures below.

CORE EXCHANGE PROCEDURE: If we do not receive your return core within 60 days, your core deposit will be retained. Complete the Core Exchange form and return it with a copy of your receipt & the core using the original packing box to:

CORE DEPOSIT REFUND AMOUNT: The components of the lower unit are the housing, vertical drive shaft & the horizontal prop-shaft

Core deposits are determined as follows: 70% of the core value is returned for a defective free housing 15% of the core value is returned for a good drive-shaft 15% of the core value is returned for a good prop-shaft

Thus, if all 3 parts are reusable, 100% of the core deposit is returned. All of the parts must be present regardless of the condition to be eligible for the deposit return. We retain sole discretion to determine if a core is re-buildable.
